General Spelling Bee Information

- 1. On competition day, competition start times are approximate and may begin sooner than scheduled in order to expedite the number of competitions being held. Successive competitions will begin when the round before it ends.
- 2. Contestants in subsequent spelling bees may <u>not</u> be in the competition room prior to their own Spelling Bee.
- 3. No spelling lists are allowed in the room with the exception of the judges' and moderator's copies.
- 4. It is important to make the Spellmaster and judges aware of any accents or speech impediments that a contestant may have. Please make this known before the spelling bee so that the competition can run smoothly. Perhaps speaking with the child beforehand can help to eliminate frustration and embarrassment.
- 5. The competition will be recorded for judges' use only.
- 6. Capitalization of a word (whether omitted or added) shall not constitute an error.
- 7. Students are not required to provide judging forms for Spelling.
- 8. Students should not be facing the audience at any time.
- 9. When not spelling, all contestants will be seated in order. Words will be given to students from left to right. Students must come forward to the microphone or tape recorder at their turn. All spectators must remain quiet. No one may enter or exit the spelling bee room during competition.

Level 1 Spelling Rules:

- 1. Words shall be announced according to the diacritical markings in the Merriam-Webster Online Dictionary. With the approval of the judges, the Spellmaster may give a fuller explanation of the meaning of the word to supplement the dictionary definition. First grade and 2nd & 3rd grade words will include a sentence.
- 2. In competition, after the Spellmaster gives the contestant a word, the contestant should pronounce the word before spelling it. This way the Spellmaster is assured that the student has heard the correct word. Timing begins when the student says or writes the first letter of the given word. If the student begins to spell and then asks for more information, the timing continues. Requests should be made before the student begins to spell. (Students will be provided with paper and pencil if they choose to write the word and then spell it aloud.)
- 3. The contestant may request the Spellmaster to pronounce the word again, define it, or use it in a sentence. The Spellmaster shall grant the request until the judges agree that the word has been made reasonably clear to the contestant. Judges may disqualify any contestant who ignores a request to start spelling. Once again, timing begins when the student says or writes the first letter of the word.
- 4. The contestant has exactly fifteen seconds to spell the word once he has begun to spell the word aloud or write it on paper.
- 5. Having started to spell a word, a contestant may stop and begin again, retracing the spelling from the beginning, but in retracing there can be no change of letters or their sequence.
- 6. Upon missing the spelling of two words, the contestant immediately drops out of the contest. The next word on the Spellmaster's list is then given to the next contestant.
- 7. When the contestants are reduced to two and only one of them has misspelled a word and the other has no misses, the competition continues as previously stated. If the student with one miss misspells another word and the other student still has not missed a word, then the student with no errors is declared the winner. However, if he misses one word, go to the next explanation of rules.
- 8. When the contestants are reduced to two and **both contestants have missed one word**, the elimination procedure changes. At that point, when one contestant misspells a word, the other contestant shall be given an opportunity to spell that same word and the next word on the list. If

- the second contestant spells both words correctly, then the second contestant shall be declared the champion.
- 9. Any question relating to the judging of a word should be referred to the judges before the beginning of the next round. Only school sponsors may make a challenge. Parents may not voice a concern to the Spellmaster or to the school sponsor. Challenge cards shall be given to the school sponsors. (School sponsors must be someone appointed by the school and may not be a parent of the contestant.) You must have someone appointed to represent your school before the bee begins.) These challenge cards should be held up at the end of the round when there is a challenge. When the competition is down to two contestants, the challenge must be made immediately, that is, before the second contestant would spell that same word. Host schools will tape the contest and will refer to the recording in the event of a dispute.

10. The judges are in complete control of the bee. Their decision shall be final on all questions.

- 11. Three levels of spelling competitions will be held. The three levels are as follows:
 - a. First Grade (One student from each school may compete.)
 - b. Second and Third Grades (Two students from each school may compete.)
 - c. Fourth through Sixth Grades (Three students from each school may compete.)
- 12.A study list will be used in the competitions. These lists will be available early in the year for competition study.
- 13.Once of minimum of three rounds of words from a particular list have been given to the contestants, the Spellmaster selects words on the next grade level high list to continue the competition. Therefore, first grade students would go on to the 2nd and 3rd grade list and so forth.
- 14. Should more than one student be eliminated in the third-place rank, those eliminated in that round should rejoin the competition for the third place.
